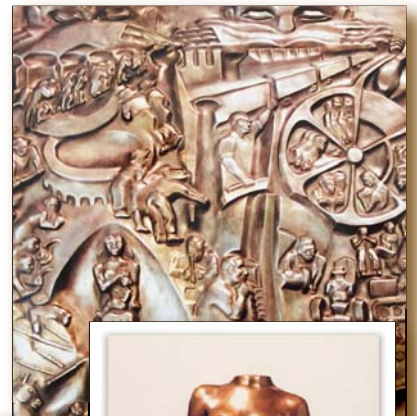
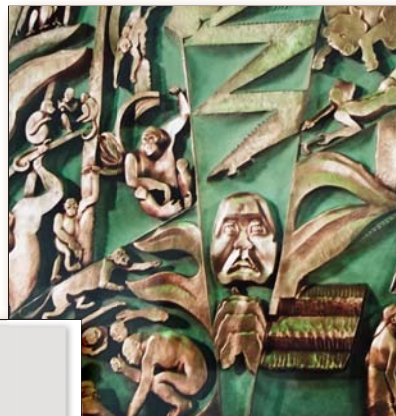

## Prominent Sculptor Margaret Bressler Kane presented by Jay Kane



*On returning from a visit to the Smithsonian American Art Museum in Washington, DC, Jay will show images of the sculpture Harlem Dancers, created in stone by his mother, the sculptor, Margaret Brassler Kane (1909-2006). Margaret Brassler Kane was a prominent 20th Century American sculptor. "Harlem Dancers", her most well-known work, has been viewed by hundreds of thousands of visitors in the Smithsonian American Art Museum and on tour over the past 25 years. Jay will describe her work in clay, plaster, wood, stone, and bronze. There are 60 sculptures spanning 75 years that documented the Depression, World War II, and other historic events. He will have on display a bronze of "Torso" which is an exact copy of the sculpture that Donald Trump acquired for his private collection 30 years ago.*

## DIRECTIONS

### Riverside Yacht Club, 102 Club Rd., Riverside, CT

Take exit 5 and proceed to the traffic signal at the end of the ramp. Turn left at the light and proceed west on Route 1 (East Putnam Ave./Post Rd.). Proceed through the next traffic signal. The second traffic signal will be at the intersection of Route 1 and Riverside Ave. A large brick church (St. Catherine of Sienna) will be on your far left corner. Turn left onto Riverside Ave. and proceed about a mile down the road, over the railroad bridge. At the stop sign, bear right to continue on Riverside Avenue. Club Rd. will be the second road on your right after the bridge. Turn right onto Club Rd. and proceed to the end to enter Riverside Yacht Club.

### Trips, 348 Hope St., Stamford, CT

From I-95 north: Exit 9, left at light and left at second light, then right onto Courtland Ave./CT 106. Follow to end, turn left onto Glenbrook Road, stay straight to Church Street (church on right). Turn right onto Hope St. 368 is on the left. From I-95 south: Exit 9, right on U.S. 1/East Main, 1st right onto Courtland Ave./CT 106, follow direx above.

### Zody's 19th Hole, E.G. Brennan Golf Course, Stamford, CT

From I-95 north: Take exit 6/Harvard Ave. At end of ramp, go straight one block. Turn left at next light onto West Ave., go straight across Post Road, then bear left around the island, turning onto Stillwater Ave. Continue on Stillwater about 1/8 mi. On your right you will see the golf course. Turn into the parking lot. From I-95 south: turn right off of exit 6 onto West Ave., then follow direx above.
