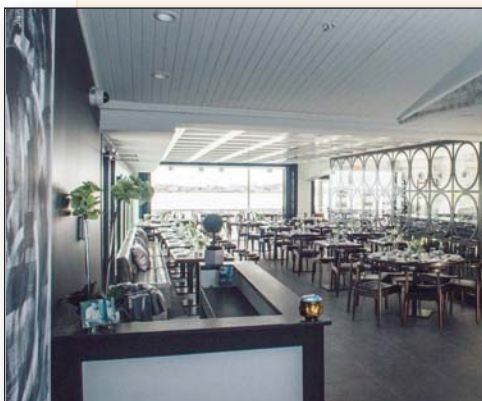

## DIRECTIONS

**Lew Clark's home, 24 Creeping Hemlock, Norwalk, CT.** I-95 to Exit 15 or Merritt Pkwy. exit 39B. At the end of the Route 7 Connector, turn right. Turn left at next light (DMV in front of you) onto Route 7. At next light, immediately before Walmart, turn right. Go up hill to the first right, Creeping Hemlock. No. 24 is at the top of the hill on left. Green house, white trim. Park on street or pull up onto grass in front of the house.

**Pearl Restaurant, Inn at Longshore, 260 Compo Road South, Westport, CT 06880** I-95 N: Exit 17 toward Westport/Saugatuck. Straight to Riverside Ave./CT 136. Take first right onto Bridge St., then right onto Compo Rd. Turn right when you see signs for Inn at Longshore, Pearl Restaurant. Follow around golf course until you get to the second parking lot on the far left side. Do not park in the first large lot as the second lot is directly in front of the restaurant. I-95 S: Exit 18, keep right to take ramp toward RR Station/Westport Country Playhouse/Westport. Merge onto Sherwood Island connector. Take second left onto Greens Farms Rd. Turn left onto Compo Rd. Pearl is on right.

**Trips, 348 Hope St., Stamford, CT** From I-95 N: Exit 9, left at light and left at second light, then right onto Courtland Ave./CT 106. Follow to end, turn left onto Glenbrook Road, stay straight to Church Street (with church on your right). Turn right onto Hope Street. 368 is on the left. From I-95 S: Exit 9, right on U.S. 1/East Main, 1st right onto Courtland Ave./CT 106, follow direx above.

**Zody's 19th Hole, E. Gaynor Brennan Golf Course, Stamford** From I-95 N: Take exit 6/Harvard Ave. At end of ramp, go straight one block. Turn left at next light onto West Ave., go straight across Post Road, then bear left around island, turning onto Stillwater Ave. Continue on Stillwater about 1/8 mi. On your right you will see golf course. Turn into parking lot. From I-95 S: turn right off of exit 6 onto West Ave., then follow the directions above.
