#### Jon Nakamatsu, Piano

American pianist Jon Nakamatsu continues to draw unanimous praise as a true aristocrat of the keyboard, whose playing combines



elegance, clarity, and electrifying power. A native of California, Mr. Nakamatsu came to international attention in 1997 when he was named Gold Medalist of the Tenth Van Cliburn International Piano Competition, the only American to have achieved this distinction since 1981.

Mr. Nakamatsu records exclusively for the prestigious Harmonia Mundi USA label, which has released eleven CDs to date. His all-Gershwin recording rose to number three on Billboard's classical music charts, earning extraordinary critical praise.

Of his 2014 release, a solo disc of piano works of Robert Schumann, BBC Music Magazine states that "Nakamatsu clarifies Schumann's mid-range saturated textures to a remarkable degree, reveling in its fantastic imaginings with rapier-like precision and effortless command."

#### DIRECTIONS

#### Asiana Restaurant, 130 East Putnam Ave., Greenwich, CT

About 1 mile West of Christ Church on US 1 (Post Road), on the corner of Milbank and US 1. Easy Parking in the rear of the restaurant, off of Milbank Ave.

#### Greenwich Symphony, Greenwich High School Performing Arts Center at 10 Hillside Road, Greenwich, CT

I-95N or S: Head toward New Haven, take exit 4 toward Indian Field Road/Cos Cob. Turn left toward Indian Field Road. Turn left onto E. Putnam Ave. /U.S. 1. Take second right onto Hillside Road. #10 is on left.

#### Loraine Salerno, 11 Tomahawk Lane, Greenwich 06830

"Basic" directions from Christ Church, Greenwich, 3.2 miles: Turn left on E. Putnam Ave., turn right onto North Street, right on Doubling Rd., continue on Doubling Rd. to Stanwich Rd; turn right onto Stanwich Rd., continue on Rustic View Rd. to Tomahawk Ln.

#### Trips, 348 Hope St., Stamford, CT

From I-95 north: Exit 9, left at light and left at second light, then right onto Courtland Ave./CT 106. Follow to end, turn left onto Glenbrook Road, stay straight to Church Street (church on right). Turn right onto Hope St. 368 is on the left. From I-95 south: Exit 9, right on U.S. 1/East Main, 1st right onto Courtland Ave./CT 106, follow direx above.

#### Zody's 19th Hole, E.G. Brennan Golf Course, Stamford, CT

From I-95 north: Take exit 6/Harvard Ave. At end of ramp, go straight one block. Turn left at next light onto West Ave., go straight across Post Road, then bear left around the island, turning onto Stillwater Ave. Continue on Stillwater about 1/8 mi. On your right you will see the golf course. Turn into the parking lot. From I-95 south: turn right off of exit 6 onto West Ave., then follow direx above.
