Asiana Restaurant, 130 East Putnam Ave.,

Greenwich, CT. I-95 to exit 4. Right from I-95 north. Left from I-95 south. At light, turn left onto Post Road, About 1 mile West of Christ Church on US 1 (Post Road), on the corner of Milbank and US 1. Easy Parking in the rear of the restaurant. off of Milbank Ave.

Lew Clark's home, 24 Creeping Hemlock,

Norwalk, CT. I-95 to Exit 15 or Merritt Pkwy. exit 39B. At end of Route 7 Connector, turn right. Turn left at next light onto Route 7 (DMV in front of you). At next light, immediately before Walmart, turn right. Go up hill to the first right, Creeping Hemlock. No. 24 is at the top of the hill on left. Green house, white trim. Park on street

or pull up onto grass in front of the house. Lugano, 1392 E Putnam Ave., Old Greenwich CT. I-95 N or S to Exit 5, turn right onto E. Putnam. Lugano is on the right about .4 miles down.
