DIRECTIONS

Old Greenwich Social Club, 148 Sound Beach Ave., Old Greenwich, CT

I-95 North/South to exit 5. Turn right onto East Putnam Ave./US 1. Turn right onto Sound Beach Ave. 148 is on the left before the train station, in the shopping center with the People's United Bank on the corner.

Riverside Yacht Club, 102 Club Rd., Riverside, CT

I-95 exit 5, turn left at the light and proceed west on Route 1 (East Putnam Ave./Post Rd.). Proceed through the next traffic signal. The second traffic signal will be at the intersection of Route 1 and Riverside Ave. A large brick church (St. Catherine of Sienna) will be on your far left corner. Turn left onto Riverside Ave. and proceed about a mile down the road, over the railroad bridge. At the stop sign, bear right to continue on Riverside Avenue. Club Rd. will be the second road on your right after the bridge. Turn right onto Club Rd. and proceed to the end to enter Riverside Yacht Club.

Zody's 19th Hole, E. Gaynor Brennan Golf Course, Stamford, CT

From I-95 N: Take exit 6/Harvard Ave. At end of ramp, go straight one block. Turn left at next light onto West Ave., go straight across Post Road, then bear left around island, turning onto Stillwater Ave. Continue on Stillwater about 1/8 mi. On your right you will see golf course. Turn into parking lot. From I-95 S: turn right off of exit 6 onto West Ave., then follow the directions above.
