







Church Library, 7-9 p.m. Bring a food donation or beverage. Bring an unwrapped toy for a child or preteen. Toys will be distributed to local families.





DIRECTIONS:

Lew Clark's home, 24 Creeping Hemlock, Norwalk, CT. I-95 to Exit 15 or Merritt Pkwy. exit 39B. At end of Route 7 Connector, turn right. Turn left at next light onto Route 7 (DMV in front of you). At next light, immediately before Walmart, turn right. Go up hill to the first right, Creeping Hemlock. No. 24 is at the top of the hill on left. Green house, white trim. Park on street or pull up onto grass in front of the house.

Lugano, 1392 E Putnam Ave., Old Greenwich CT. I-95 N or S to Exit 5, turn right onto E. Putnam. Lugano is on the right about .4 miles down.

Madonia Restaurant, 1297 Long Ridge Rd., Stamford, CT. Merritt Exit 34 (Long Ridge Rd), exit from ramp, go north on CT104 (Long Ridge Road), go .8 mile, Madonia's is on the right. If you reach Den Road you've gone too far.

Tony's at J House, 1114 East Putnam Ave., Greenwich, CT. I-95 NORTH AND SOUTH: Exit 5. Turn left. J House will be on your left in about a quarter of a mile.
