Cosi, 129 West Putnam Ave., Greenwich I-95 south to Exit 3, turn right onto Arch St. From I-95 north, turn left onto Arch St. Take the 3rd left onto Sound View Dr., just past Railroad Ave. Turn right onto Field Pt. Rd. Take the 3rd left onto W. Putnam Ave./ U.S. 1. Cosi is on the right in the Stop & Shop

shopping center, next to Chase bank.

Directions: From north: I-95 to Exit 4, Indian Field Road. Turn right. Go straight across Post Rd (U.S. 1). Take first left onto Stanwich Rd. Go approximately 2 miles. Turn right on Rustic View. Go one block. Turn left on Tomahawk Lane. No. 11 is at end of Tomahawk. From south: I95 to Exit 4 (Indian Field Road. Turn left, then continue as above. Go straight across Post Road (U.S. 1). Plenty of parking!

Mackenzie's Grill Room, Old Greenwich

From I-95 (North or South): Take exit 5, the US-1 N exit, toward Stamford/Old Greenwich. Turn right onto E. Putnam Ave./US-1.

CVS Pharmacy in Riverside Commons is on the corner. Take the 1st right onto Sound Beach Ave. (just past the Getty Mart on the corner). If you reach Boulder Ave. you've gone about 0.1 mile too far. Mackenzie's is on the left just before the train tracks.

Zody's 19th Hole, E. Gaynor Brennan Golf Course, Stamford

From I-95 north: Take exit 6/Harvard Ave. At end of ramp, go straight one block. Turn left at next light onto West Ave., go straight across Post Road, then bear left around the island, turning onto Stillwater Ave. Continue on Stillwater about 1/8 mi. On your right you will see the Hubbard Heights golf course. Turn into the parking lot. From I-95 south: turn right off of exit 6 onto West Ave., then follow the directions above.
