Greenwich Club is Proud to Offer Paint Nite to All Members


Please join us in the Vestry Room (across from the library) where you'll have the opportunity to express your creative self in an acrylic painting for display in your home.

DIRECTIONS

Lugano, 1392 East Putnam Ave., Old Greenwich, CT 06870 I-95-N/S to Exit 5, turn right. Lugano is on the right.

From I-95 N: Exit 9, left at light and left at second light, then right onto Courtland Ave./CT 106. Follow to end, turn left onto Glenbrook Road, stay straight to Church Street (with church on your right). Turn right onto Hope Street. 368 is on the left. From I-95 S: Exit 9, right on U.S. 1/East Main, 1st right onto Courtland Ave./CT 106, follow direx above.
