24 Creeping Hemlock, Norwalk, CT
I-95 to Exit 15 or Merritt Pkwy. exit 39B. At the end of the Route 7 Connector, turn right. Turn left at next light (DMV in front of you) onto Route 7. At next light, immediately before Walmart, turn right. Go up hill to the first right, Creeping Hemlock. No. 24 is at the top of the hill on left. Green house, white trim. Park on street or pull up onto grass in front of the house.
